- Provide training in accordance with the Advisor Course CDD/POI and the following specific combat driving skills: Convoy planning and operations training Tactical vehicle planning/employment of HMMWV/Commercial Vehicles (both manual and automatic transmission)/4WD in austere environments; Operation of HMMWVs/MRAPs/MATVs, SUVs, pickup and other light commercial trucks in a tactical convoy; Operation of commercial/civilian vehicles in a combat environment; Vehicle movement in a combat (IEDs/VBIEDs intensive) environment.
- Training requires that SMEs be authorized to handle and fire the weapons for safety and demonstration purposes.
- This position may require travel to alternate training venues.
- Performance of duties shall be in a combination of classroom and field conditions.
