

Position Title:
**TRANSITION TEAM BORDER/PORT
OF ENTRY POLICE TRAINER (SME)**



BCDS is actively recruiting Veterans with recent OEF/OIF experience and Border Patrol/Customs Agent experience.

Position Responsibilities Include:

- Serve as a Border/Customs/Immigration specific “subject matter expert” and training coordinator for the IMEF ATC.
- Assist in the development and update of lesson plans in accordance with the USMC Systems Approach to Training (SAT) User’s Guide. Provide technical input and updates in development of Program of Instruction (POI) and training materials for the courses of instruction.
- Assist with the development and implementation of a customs/border specific training curriculum, that shall enable Marine Advisors who have no previous knowledge of Border Patrol/Customs to gain a basic understanding of *border specific* Tactics, Techniques and Procedures so that once deployed they may effectively train, mentor and advise the Iraqi/Afghani Law Enforcement units to which they are assigned.
- Training requires that SMEs be authorized to handle and fire the weapons for safety and demonstration purposes.
- This position may require travel to alternate training venues.
- Performance of duties shall be in a combination of classroom and field conditions.

Civilian Education:

REQUIRED: High School diploma or equivalent required.

DESIRED: College degree.

Military Education:

REQUIRED: Certification as Marine Corps Range Safety Officers (RSO).

DESIRED: Prior Military Experience is preferred. Train the Trainer School (T3S) within last four years from date of hire a plus.

Military/Government Experience:

REQUIRED: Previous work experience as a Border Patrol/Customs Agent and previous experience as an FTO (Field Training Officer) or Basic Border Patrol/Customs Academy Instructor.

Knowledge and understanding of basic police training, firearms, defensive tactics, inspections, investigations, evidence collections, prosecution preparations, fraudulent document detection, and ability to instruct. The incumbent should possess a networking knowledge and be able to develop training sources from outside the traditional military structure. The incumbent should have an understanding of the duties of Transition Training Team advisors to foreign forces

(Iraqi Army, Iraqi Police, Border Patrol or Port of Entry) and be conversant with the nuances and intricacies of those duties.

DESIRED: Previous experience serving as a Transition Team Trainer (Advisor) to the Iraqi or Afghanistan Army, Police, Border Patrol or Port of Entry Forces would be a plus. Prior SRT or SWAT team experience would be an advantage. The trainer should have sufficient knowledge and understanding.

Other:

This position may require travel to alternate training venues. Performance of duties shall be in a combination of classroom and field conditions.

Clearance:

REQUIRED: Secret Clearance. Position shall require access to Secret material and systems.
